

It is very rare to have an opportunity to donate to a project, knowing that every cent will go directly into funding that project rather than be absorbed by professional fund-raising or organizing costs. Consider the costs of the medicinal ingredients alone, some difficult to collect from remote mountainsides, others such as sandalwood found far south in India, some expensive because of rarity (such as coral, gold, lapis, or dzi). Consider the cost of gathering books and furnishing the long traditional study tables, or for the construction of Dr. Ngawang's planned heated herbal bath, herbal massage clinic, and warm sleeping quarters. Consider contributing to this effort to make some of the best of traditional wisdom available to everyone in this era.
